INDICATION

Controlice® Defence Shampoo contains active ingredients, which can help repel head lice and avoid re-infestation. Efficacy of support may vary between users.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

Do not use if known hypersensitivity or allergy exists towards any of the ingredients.

WARNINGS AND SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY. Do not use if known hypersensitivity or allergy exists towards citral, citronellol, limonene, linalool or any of the other ingredients. Do not apply to damaged or broken skin. Avoid contact with eyes and mucous membranes. If product gets into eyes, wash out immediately with water, and seek medical advice. Upon accidental ingestion, do not induce vomiting. Drink plenty of water, and seek medical advice. Products containing herbal ingredients may interact with some medication. If you are taking any chronic medication, do not use this product without consulting your medical practitioner. Use only as directed. Do not use after date of expiry. See expiry date on unit. Keep away from open flames.

DOSAGE AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY.

Use only as directed. Keep away from open flames.

1. Test for sensitivity on the inside of the forearm.
 2. Use Controlice® Defence Shampoo to cleanse hair or during a lice outbreak, to repel head lice.
 3. Wet the hair.
 4. Apply shampoo and work into a lather.
 5. Leave on for 3-5 minutes.
 6. Rinse off. Repeat if required.
 7. Style hair as normal.
- For daily use.

SIDE EFFECTS

If you experience any side effects or sensitivity towards citral, citronellol, limonene, linalool or any of the other ingredients, discontinue use. If symptoms persist, or if any adverse reactions occur, consult your medical practitioner. Side effects may include, but are not limited to allergic skin reactions such as rash and contact dermatitis.

KNOWN SYMPTOMS OF OVERDOSAGE AND PARTICULARS OF ITS TREATMENT

There are no known symptoms of overdosage. However, if irritation or any other adverse reactions occur, please consult a medical practitioner. Treatment is symptomatic and supportive.

LICE FACTS

Head lice are small, fast crawling parasites that feed on human blood. They're clear in colour when first hatched, and then quickly develop a reddish-brown colour after feeding. An adult louse is about the size of a pin head and their nits (eggs) are about two thirds smaller. In order to survive, lice need to feed on the blood of their hosts every 3-4 hours. While on their hosts they also extend the lice population by mating every 3-4 hours. On average they stay alive between 23-30 days.

WHO GETS HEAD LICE AND HOW DO THEY GET THEM?

Only humans can get head lice. If stranded away from the human scalp they die quickly (1-2 days). The usual way people are infested is from direct hair-to-hair contact with another person. Head lice don't have wings therefore they cannot fly or jump from head to head without assistance, but they are terrific runners and they can hide. Head lice have six legs and grasp the hair with claws.

Lice infestations can come from almost anywhere:

A classmate, another child's clothing, hat, comb or brush.

Lice outbreaks are common among school children and even the cleanest child can easily become infested. During a lice infestation, it is important that you INSPECT all family members for at least two weeks.

Head lice should be suspected when there is intense itching of the scalp and/or at the nape of the neck. You will see small, whitish nits attached to the hair shaft. Head lice may also be indicated if one finds tiny, black spots on bed pillows, sheets or clothing near the neckline and shoulders. These black spots consist of digested blood excreted by a head louse after feeding.

ATTACK:

The active ingredients in Controlice® Oil Spray / Controlice® Head Rinse can be used to eliminate head lice already infesting the hair. It is very important to use the product as directed. After using the Controlice® Oil Spray / Controlice® Head Rinse, it is necessary to comb out all the nits and dead head lice with a Controlice® Comb. The Controlice® Combs are precision engineered products that are very effective in removing nits. The unique tooth configuration provides a gentle scraping action which dislodged lice and nits without damaging the hair. Use the Controlice® Lice Buster for long hair and the Controlice® Lice Comb for short hair.

Important: Repeat treatment and combing after 7 days.

PROTECT:

Controlice® Defence Shampoo and / or Controlice® Defence Spray contain active ingredients which repel head lice and protect against head lice infestation during a lice outbreak. It can be used by adults and children. Use the Controlice® Combs on a regular basis to check for head lice.
