1. What Viagro® Bio Capsules is and what it is used for

Viagro® Bio Capsules is a health supplement containing nutrients in quantities targeted for promoting healthy hair and normal hair growth. Viagro® Bio Capsules also promotes the health of skin and nails. Viagro® Bio Capsules contains antioxidants which can assist in prevention of cellular oxidative damage.

2. What you need to know before you take Viagro® Bio Capsules

Do not take Viagro® Bio Capsules:

- If you are hypersensitive (allergic) to any of the ingredients of Viagro® Bio Capsules (listed in section 6 **Contents of pack and other information**).
- If you suffer from liver disease or have a stomach ulcer (peptic ulcer disease) as Viagro® Bio Capsules contains nicotinamide and manganese.
- If you have cobalamin or cobalt hypersensitivity as Viagro® Bio Capsules capsules contains vitamin B12.

Warnings and precautions

- Consult a healthcare provider before use if you have a history of non-melanoma skin cancer as Viagro® Bio Capsules contain selenium.
- The Viagro® Bio Capsules is not intended to support prostate health or treat disease. Consult a healthcare provider before use if you have been diagnosed or suspected to suffer from prostate cancer.
- Special care should be taken if you are pregnant or breastfeeding or taking antibiotics (sulfonamides), as Viagro® Bio Capsules contains PABA.
- If you are taking any chronic medication, do not use without consulting your medical practitioner.
- Do not exceed the daily recommended dose (see **3. How to take Viagro® Bio Capsules capsules**)
- Do not use after the date of expiry.

Porphyria: Safety has not been established.

Tell your doctor if you are not sure about any of the above.

Other medicines and Viagro® Bio Capsules

Always tell your healthcare provider if you are taking any other medicine (including complementary or traditional medicines).

Consult your doctor, pharmacist or healthcare provider before use if you are taking:

- Blood thinners (anticoagulant or anti-platelet medication e.g. Warfarin) as vitamin B3 and selenium may have a blood thinning effect increasing the risk of bleeding and bruising; or
- antibiotics (used to treat infections), as the minerals and Para-aminobenzoic acid (PABA) in Viagro® Bio Capsules may reduce their absorption. You should take all oral antibiotics at least two (2) hours before, or four (4) hours after Viagro® Bio Capsules or similar supplements; or
- sulfones (decreases swelling and stops the growth of bacteria) as PABA may inhibit the antibacterial effects, avoid concurrent/ simultaneous use.

Taking Viagro® Bio Capsules with food and drink and alcohol

You should take Viagro® Bio Capsules capsules after a meal with a glass of water a few hours before or after taking other medications or health products.

Pregnancy and Breastfeeding

It is not advisable to take Viagro® Bio Capsules while you are pregnant or breastfeeding as it contains Para-aminobenzoic acid (PABA) which is specifically contraindicated. If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, think you might be pregnant or are planning to have a baby, please consult your doctor or pharmacist or other healthcare provider for advice before taking this medication.

Driving and using machines

Viagro® Bio Capsules should not affect your ability to drive or use machinery. However, if you think you are affected you should not drive or operate machinery until you feel better.

3. How to take Viagro® Bio Capsules

Do not share medicines with any other person.

Always take Viagro® Bio Capsules exactly as described in this leaflet or as your healthcare provider has instructed you. You should check with your doctor, pharmacist or nurse if you are unsure.

The usual dose for adults 18 years and older:

- Maintenance dosage: One (1) capsule per day, after a meal, with a glass of water.
- Acute dosage: Two (2) capsules per day, after a meal, with a glass of water.

Take a few hours before or after taking other medications (see **Other medicines with Viagro® Bio Capsules**)

If you take more Viagro® Bio Capsules than you should

In the event of overdosage, consult your doctor or pharmacist. If neither is available, contact the nearest hospital or poison centre.

If you forget to take Viagro® Bio Capsules

Take your missed dose when you remember. Do not take a double dose to make up for forgotten individual doses.

If you stop taking Viagro® Bio Capsules

If you are taking the dose as indicated, it is unlikely that there should be withdrawal effects when you stop using this medication.

4. Possible side effects

Viagro® Bio Capsules can have side effects

Not all side effects reported for Viagro® Bio Capsules are included in this leaflet. Should your general health worsen while or if you experience any untoward effects while taking this medicine, please consult your healthcare provider for advice.

If any of the following or other side effects occur, stop taking this product and consult your doctor or pharmacist or go to the casualty department at your nearest hospital:

Allergic reactions such as: skin inflammation or rash, difficulty breathing or swallowing, swelling beneath the skin (angioedema), itchy throat, urticaria (hives) and itching.

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you notice any of the following:

Frequency unknown:

- Abdominal complaints (such as; Stomach discomfort, pain, cramps and fullness, constipation, diarrhoea, indigestion, heartburn, nausea, vomiting, bad breath, and dry mouth).

If you notice any side effects not mentioned in this leaflet, please inform your doctor or pharmacist.

Reporting of side effects

If you get side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. You can also report side effects to SAHPRA via the

5. How to store Viagro® Bio Capsules

- STORE ALL MEDICINES OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- Store in a dry place at or below 25 °C.
- Protect from light and moisture.
- Keep in original packing until required for use.
- Do not refrigerate.
- Do not store in a bathroom.
- Do not use after the expiry date stated on the label and carton.
- Return all unused medicine to your pharmacist.
- Do not dispose of unused medicine in drains or sewerage systems (e.g. toilets).
